MASSSES—LEVEL 2

It's great to be back in our churches, though please do be aware of the Level 2 Diocesan directives, for the use of our churches at this time, which we ask everyone to follow:

- Wear a face covering
- Sanitise hands on entry
- Scan the QR code or manually sign in using a ballot entry (mandatory)
- Keep 2-meters social distancing (family groups)
- Receive Holy Communion in the hand
- 100 person limit indoors

Sunday Masses—6 Across the City

Last weekend there was lots of room for more people to come to Mass, particularly both Masses at St Mary's Church—please consider coming this weekend :-)

Bookings are not needed to attend Masses

Sunday Masses will be very simple in nature during this Level 2, meaning there will be no singing, altar servers, sign of peace or offertory procession. The collection will take place as people leave the church

Weekday Masses

The weekday Mass timetable is as normal, though there is no public Mass at Cullinane presently.

FUNERALS IN LEVEL 2—100 Limit

This means that in many cases families will need to limit the number of those present at a Funeral Mass or Service. So all of us need to wait until we are invited to attend a Funeral Mass, unless it is announced that anyone can attend. This is particularly hard for us, for we have been taught that to "bury the dead" is a work of mercy. In our present circumstances you can ask one of the priests to offer Mass for the deceased and family as a way of being intimately involved in farewelling our friend and commending them into God's merciful hands.

If you wish to leave a card of condolence at the Parish Office it will be delivered to the family at the Funeral.

Please also be aware that at Level 2 funeral receptions (refreshments) are not able to take place in our Church facilities. This can recommence at Level 1.

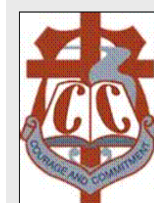
