Walking on Water A few years ago, I read a book called "The Lost Art of Walking on Water". I read it on the basis of the title (I sometimes judge books by their cover:) but it was nothing like what I was expecting. It was a carefully considered critique of priesthood in this modern age and very helpful. Today's gospel is very down to earth dealing with two topics - fear and prayer. A simple observation. When we are afraid, our prayers are often short and to the point. Peter, having stepped out of the boat found himself sinking and he cries out to Jesus, "Lord save me!"
