#### Roberts' Ramble

On Friday morning I listened to an extended but compassionate report on the disaster at Abbev Caves. I was deeply saddened.

As I walked to the shower I found myself praying not only for the young man who had died and his family, but for the teacher and instructor, his fellow students and the whole school - parents, teachers, support personnel and students alike.

I know that many of us will be praying for all sorts of events happening not only in New Zealand but overseas as well. I pray for peace in the Ukraine every day. I often pray for the Uighur people of China and the displaced Rohingia people of Mvanmar.

I can be easy to leave such matters to "the experts", our contemplative nuns and monks. Loving our neighbours in intercessory prayer is, I suggest, recognising that the ones we think of, hear or read about are our neighbours too.

The Church asks us to undertake such praying at Sunday Mass too. I tried an experiment with a group of teenagers some years ago. When I asked them to pray for mothers in difficulties their prayers were limited to that group, when I asked them simply to pray for fathers their reported prayers were wide ranging; we heard of fathers at work, fathers teaching their children sporting skills, how to maintain house and garden, fathers away from home and so on. It is amazing what people will pray for when given the opportunity.

I keep hoping that I am responding to the Holy Spirit and the needs of my world-wide neighbours when I turn to intercessory prayer.

### **CARDINAL JOHN DEW RETIRES AS** CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF WELLINGTON

Cardinal John Dew, the Catholic Archbishop of Wellington since 2005, has retired on reaching his 75th birthday.

Pope Francis accepted Cardinal John's formal resignation as Archbishop of Wellington and made the announcement on 5 May in Rome. Coadjutor Archbishop Paul Martin SM succeeds Cardinal John as Archbishop of Wellington.

Cardinal John remains as Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Palmerston North and continues with his various Vatican roles, including membership of the College of Cardinals, able to take part in papal elections until aged 80.
