This Sunday's gospel reading is the Parable of the Sower. Some of the seed falls on good soil and other seed on poor soil. The point is straightforward. Good soil produces a good crop and poor soil doesn't.

The Sower is Jesus and the seed is his Word. We know the seed itself is good. What about the soil of our heart, the recipient?

We know from experience that our hearts are often drawn in many different directions. Many of us live in a world of excessive activity and busyness, a world of entertainment and distractions, all of which demand our attention. Our response to God's generosity, is to create an open heart and mind for God to speak to us. An aggressive, overly busy, distracted person cannot receive the Word until they consciously slow down, give themselves space to be still and open their hearts and minds to God. It is when we allow ourselves to be transformed by God and let go of all that consumes us that we will hear His word and become fruitful in faith, hope and love.

This week, I encourage you take some time to read a passage from the scriptures and pray, asking God to help you hear. You will be surprised by what he has to say.

Weekend Masses will stay the same. This schedule will provide certainty about a regular Mass every day at St Mary's, and opportunity for Masses involving school children from St Anne's and St Marcellin's.

First Reconciliation Preparation Next month we will begin preparing our children for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
