St Francis de Sales for whom I have an increasing admiration had this to say:

"You learn to speak by speaking, to study by studying, to work by working, and just so, you learn to love by loving. All those who think to learn any other way deceive themselves."

I recently asked a parishioner to help with a particular event. My request was willingly accepted. A day later the person reminded me that there was a previous commitment in the calendar which meant that it was impossible to keep the promise of help. But, the person had already arranged for another to help me. I was reminded how many people do "hidden things" in the parish.

We have people who arrange flowers, who leap in to help with the cuppa after Sunday Mass, who fill vacancies on Sunday rosters, who take communion to the sick every week. Others phone in to ask a priest to visit a sick or elderly person. I am sure there are others undertaking other "hidden tasks".

There are others who also faithfully serve the parish in a more public fashion; readers, ministers of communion, musicians, sacristans, and so on.

We rely on these people for the day-to-day running of the parish. Someone once made the comment that practical love is the glue which holds the Church together. It certainly holds this parish together. The quiet, determined dedication of these people is a cause for our gratitude and thanksgiving. It is also a quiet call to each of us: "Is there something I can do to "glue" the parish together?"

I pray every blessing for each of you on this Feast of Pentecost. Father John.


