COVID LIGHT CHANGE

The whole of New Zealand has moved to the RED settings of the Covid Protection Framework 11:59pm, Sunday 23 Jan, due to the omicron variant circulating in our community.

As a Parish community, we have been in the **RED** settings before, so this is nothing new to us as we will simply revert to our previous weekend Mass timetable of 6 Masses, in order to keep to the limits (100 for Vaccine Pass & 25 for No Pass).

Please also be aware that at **RED** we will be putting singing on hold at this time.

As always, please only attend those Masses/ Liturgies/Events you feel safe doing so, knowing that there is no Sunday obligation to attend Mass at this time.

If you know of anyone who is in need of spiritual support at this time, please contact the office and we will do our best to assist.
