### RED LIGHT SETTING CHANGES:

- QR code scanning ended Fri 25 March, 11:59pm
- Indoor gatherings increase to 200 (using Vac Pass until 4 April)
- Indoor gatherings where Vac Pass is not used remains at 25 until 4 April
- Use of vaccine passes ends Mon 4 April, 11:59pm
- However, masks are still required and Holy Communion will remain Hosts only.

We have now returned to 1 Mass at Holy Family and St Mary's Churches, but retain 2 Masses at St Anne's until after 3 April, when St Anne's will drop to 1 Mass beginning Sun 10 April.

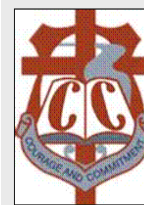
